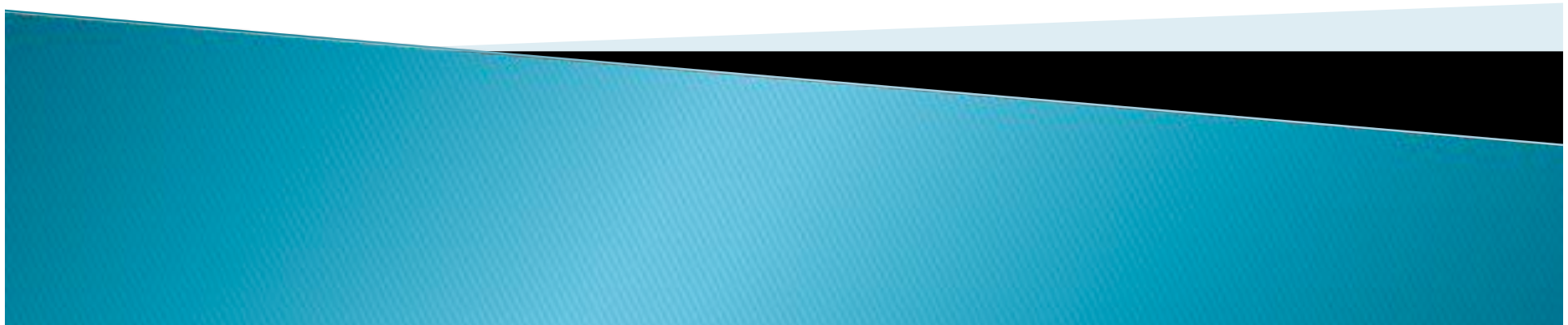


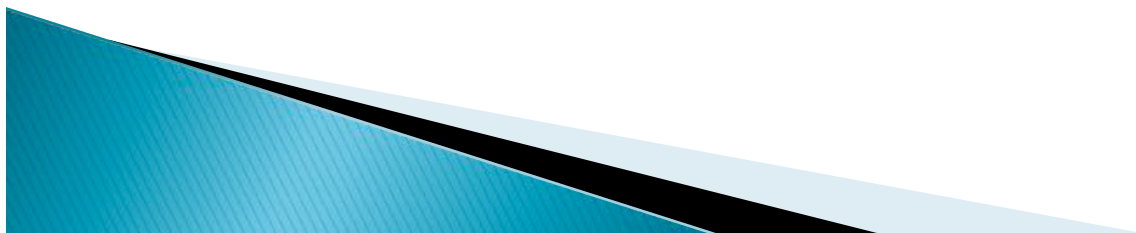
ASF SITUATION IN MASAKA DISTRICT

History of the recent outbreak

- ▶ Outbreak was first reported in Kabonera sub-county late November 2015
- ▶ Spread to 5 rural sub-counties and 3 Municipal Divisions by 10th January 2016
- ▶ Mortality rates of up to 90% reported in affected farms



Latest outbreak 10th April 2016

Measures undertaken on receipt of field reports from sub-counties of outbreak information

- ▶ District communication
- ▶ Communication to the commissioner, Animal Health and Entomology
- ▶ Communication to partners–IRLI, College of Natural Sciences Makerere university and NADDEC



Field investigation to confirm outbreak

Number sub-counties affected (Nov 2015–Jan 2016)	8
Pig population at risk	253,000
Number blood samples Collected & submitted	64
Results	
+ve strong	4
+ve weak	5
–ve	59

Measures after disease confirmation

- ▶ Temporary internal quarantine measures
- ▶ Training on Bio–security and Bio–safety measures
- ▶ Depopulation, Disinfect and restock after two months
- ▶ Distribution of posters on ASF signs, prevention and control measures (ILRI, MAAIF, Veterinarians without Borders, Irish aid)


